

Dear Mr. Mansourian,

The Southern Marin Emergency Medical Paramedic System (SMEMPS) is converting one of their ambulances into a reserve unit. This unit will only be utilized when a primary ambulance is taken out of service. To achieve this goal, and provide for turn-key operation, it is necessary to install and program two mobile and two portable MERA radios.

Given that this ambulance will only operate as a reserve unit, there should be no increase in the utilization of the MERA system.
