Dear Directors,

On December 14, 2011, the MERA Board approved an Additional Radios Policy and Procedures for additional radio requests.

The above two entities are requesting the addition of the following radios:

American Red Cross
Town of San Anselmo

These requests were vetted through the Operations Issues Work Group, and were found to be consistent with the proposed policy.

Operational concerns that were identified are being addressed on an individual basis. At this time, all of these additional radios should not have a significant negative impact on day to day operations of the MERA system. The Town of San Anselmo request is not expected to have high usage during countywide emergencies. The American Red Cross request will provide a beneficial resource for countywide emergency response.

American Red Cross would be a non-member user. On December 14, 2011 the MERA Board adopted a zero rate fee schedule for mutual aid and automatic back-up aid agencies, therefore they would not be charged a fee.

The Additional Radios Policy and Procedures requires the entity to pay for these radios and all costs associated with programming and alignment. In addition, training is recommended for all users before the radios are released for use, based on the end user curriculum approved by MERA.

Training can be provided by the entity if they have an approved trainer on staff, or provided by Marin County staff with all costs borne by the entity.

As outlined above, the waiver of the radio moratorium for these two requests, for 2 radios total, is recommended. Issues Work Group.



RE: Request to add MERA radio

Dear Executive Committee:

The San Anselmo Police Department and the Twin Cities Police Authority have entered into a Memorandum of Understanding for Shared Support Services. As part of this agreement the two agencies will be co-locating their dispatchers at the new Twin Cities Police Station at 250 Dogherty Drive, Larkspur starting January 25, 2012.

During the preparations for the new dispatch center it came to our attention that we would have a serious problem in the case of a failure of the MERA trunked system. Specifically, the Motorola Astro Spectra Consolette radios we will be using as back up base stations would not have sufficient range in a stand alone or analog mode to transmit from the new Twin Cities Police Station to San Anselmo. This would mean no radio communications between dispatch and police units in San Anselmo.

Marin County Radio Shop has provided us with a solution - to add a new stand alone Motorola Astro Sprectra base station to be located at the San Anselmo Police Department that will be controlled via phone lines by a tone remote unit at Twin Cities Police Department. We understand that this would not be a complete solution to the problem, and that portions of the Town would still be without radio coverage. However, we do not see a reasonable alternative and believe this is the best solution for this potential emergency management problem at this time.

As this new base station radio would only be used in a stand alone or analog mode we do not believe that it would have any appreciable impact on the MERA system.
