 BETWEEN MERA AND COUNTY OF MARIN
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- <u>Recommended Action</u>: Based on the Finance Committee's review and input, recommend the Proposed Technical Services Operations Agreement between MERA and County of Marin, including the Executive Officer's revision, to the MERA Board of Directors.
- Background: The current three-year agreement for Technical Services, which is paid by the Member agencies as part of MERA's Annual Operating Budget, is ending June 30, 2012. Type and cost of services provided are as follows:

The **68%**+ increase in DPW Administrative costs from FY11-12 to FY12-13 is due to the "increase in workload by Communications Maintenance personnel which include more coordination efforts because of more users and more requests, technology changes, management of the Service Level Agreement staff increased due to increased complexity of the system, technical contracts management, increased billing administration and documentation".

Due to this substantial increase in Administrative Costs over the current agreement, the MERA Executive Officer recommends that this expense be provided on a "Not to Exceed" basis and recalculated based on periodic audits of time spent on general administration.

Breakdown of the number of proposed Administrative hours and rates are as follows (Note – Breakdown does not include capital projects):
