Re: Probation Department Request: 5 Additional Radio

The Marin County Probation Department is a MERA member agency currently issued 53 MERA compliant radios. Historically, Probation was issued a modest number of radios to support occasional field visit and/or client transport need.

With the onset of Public Safety Realignment in 2011, the Probation Department has been steadily increasing their presence in the field and the number of radios has increased in conjunction. By late 2012, the Probation Department had been issued a total of 38 radios and begun to use the services of the Sheriff's dispatch center.

A radio has become a standard issue item for all Probation Officers (POs) who have caseloads that require regular work in the field. MERA training has become a part of the mandated field training requirements and the Department works closely with Sheriff's Dispatch to schedule routine refresher training.

At this time we respectfully request the issuance of an additional five radios. The Probation Department has added four additional FTE's due to Realignment, so the additional radios requested are required to equip new staff, and will also provide the ability to issue assigned radios to POs who do not have a regular field presence but often take part in operations, events and transports. Currently these officers must share the one radio that has not been assigned to a specific PO.
