Recommended Action

Receive and file Report on Measure A Low-Income Senior Exemptions.

Background

Since the passage of Measure A on November 4, 2014, and the first year's application of the parcel tax on the County Assessor's Tax Rolls in FY15-16, the breakdown of approved exemption applications for each year which are due June 1 is as follows:

<u>Fiscal Year</u>	<u>Number Approved</u>
2015-16	113
2016-17	128
2017-18	119
2018-19	136
2019-20	135
2020-21	205
2021-22	359
2022-23	350

As reported previously, three Media Advisories on the exemption process are released monthly prior to each annual deadline. Information on the exemption is posted on the MERA website homepage. The purpose of the annual exemption application is to address changes in age and income eligibility from year-to-year.
